Mark of the Beast

*By this point, the student should already know that the "beast" is the head of the Roman Catholic church.

purpose: To show that at the end of time the mark of the beast will be Sunday observance.

center it: Jesus cares enough to make us uncomfortable.

Revelation 14:9-11

- Warning! Don't receive!
- Would you like to avoid receiving the mark?
- In order to avoid the mark, we must figure out if it's literal or if it symbolizes something.

Revelation 12:9

- The serpent deceives the world.
- You wouldn't be deceived if you had a literal mark on your hand or forehead.

Deuteronomy 6:5-8

- (Exodus 13:16; Deuteronomy 11:18; Isaiah 59:6,7; Luke 9:62; Ecclesiastes 9:10)
- In the Bible, your hand represents what you do and your forehead represents what you think.
- What does the mark symbolize?

Romans 6:16

- What makes you someone's servant?
- What can identify/mark you as someone's servant?
- Brown suit/Black suit- (Commands to wear both on the same day by two different people. Decision about which suit to wear proves whose servant you are.)

Matthew 4:9,10

- Jesus correlates worship and service in verse 10. Why?
- If you worship the way Satan says, you are obeying him. If Jesus had obeyed, He would have been Satan's servant.

Revelation 13:15,16/ Revelation 14:7

• There are two calls for worship: God's and Satan's

2 Thessalonians 2:1-4

- 1. Falling away
- 2. Son of perdition
- The only other time the phrase "son of perdition" is used in the NT, it describes
- Judas Iscariot. He was apparently Christian as well.

John 17:12

- Judas was an apparent supporter of Christ. Judas was not a violent opposer.
- If Antichrist is apparently Christian, his mark must also be an apparently Christian mark.

Revelation 14:9-12

- God infers what the mark is by telling us what it is not.

Revelation 13:15-17

- Faithfulness at the end of time will cost your life.
- The decisions you make today turn you into the person you are tomorrow. If you are faithful today, it is more likely that you will be faithful in the future. It will be easier now than later, so practice now.

appeal: Two-sided flag illustration.

defend it:

Do all Sunday keepers have the mark of the beast?

- Revelation 13:15
 - o Force is going to be used to make people to worship the beast.
 - o Those who do not have the mark are not allowed to buy or sell.
 - That is not happening right now.
 - o The crisis in this verse is not happening in North America at this moment.
 - When people are compelled by force to accept it, those who do will have the mark of the beast. It will have been made plain to all.
 - None will be innocently ignorant.

- 1. Question: Which is the Sabbath day?
 - Answer: Saturday is the Sabbath day.
 - Question: Which is the Sabbath day?
