## Introduction

- Luke 10:16
  - o If a prophet of God speaks, we are hearing God through them.
  - o If we reject their message, we reject God.
- Mark 6:14-18
  - o John's message didn't originate with John?
  - o Where did it come from?
  - o Who was Herod really hearing and rejecting?
- Luke 23:8,9
  - o Why wouldn't Jesus answer King Herod?
- Amos 3:7
  - o 2 Chronicles 20:20- believe in His prophets and you shall prosper.
  - o God's method fro communicating with humanity is through prophets.
- Malachi 3:6
  - o His methods won't change because He doesn't. (Hebrews 13:8)

## **Prophecy Sandwiches**

- Genesis 15:13,14
  - o Abram receives a time prophecy from God.
  - The prophecy is 400 years long.
  - o What does the prophecy concern?
- Exodus 3:7-10
  - God raises up Moses the prophet at the end of the 400-year prophecy.
  - Does his mission relate to Abram's prophecy?
  - o Abram [ 400 years ] Moses
- Jeremiah 29:10 (Jeremiah 25:11,12)
  - Jeremiah receives a 70-year time prophecy.
  - o What does it concern?
- Ezra 1:1-3; 5:1,2
  - God raises up Haggai the prophet around the end of Jeremiah's prophecy.
  - Does his mission relate to Jeremiah's prophecy?
  - o Jeremiah [ 70 years ] Haggai
- Daniel 9:25
  - o Daniel receives a time prophecy of 483 years.
  - o What does it concern?
- Mark 1:1-4,14,15
  - o God raises up John the Baptist at the end of the time prophecy.
  - Does his mission and message have anything to do with Daniel's prophecy? Yes! It has everything to do with it!
  - o Daniel [ 483 years ] John the Baptist
- Daniel 8:14,17
  - o God gives a 2,300-year prophecy through Daniel.

- o What does it concern?
- o Daniel [ <u>2,300 years</u>] ????
- o Jesus and his message is always on time!
- What then should we see around 1844? If God is going to be consistent with Himself, we should see a prophet.

## Test of a Prophet

- Isaiah 8:20
  - o Biblical faithfulness
- Deuteronomy 13:1-3
  - Commandment keeping
- Jeremiah 28:9
  - o Prophetic accuracy
- Matthew 7:15,16
  - Positive fruit
